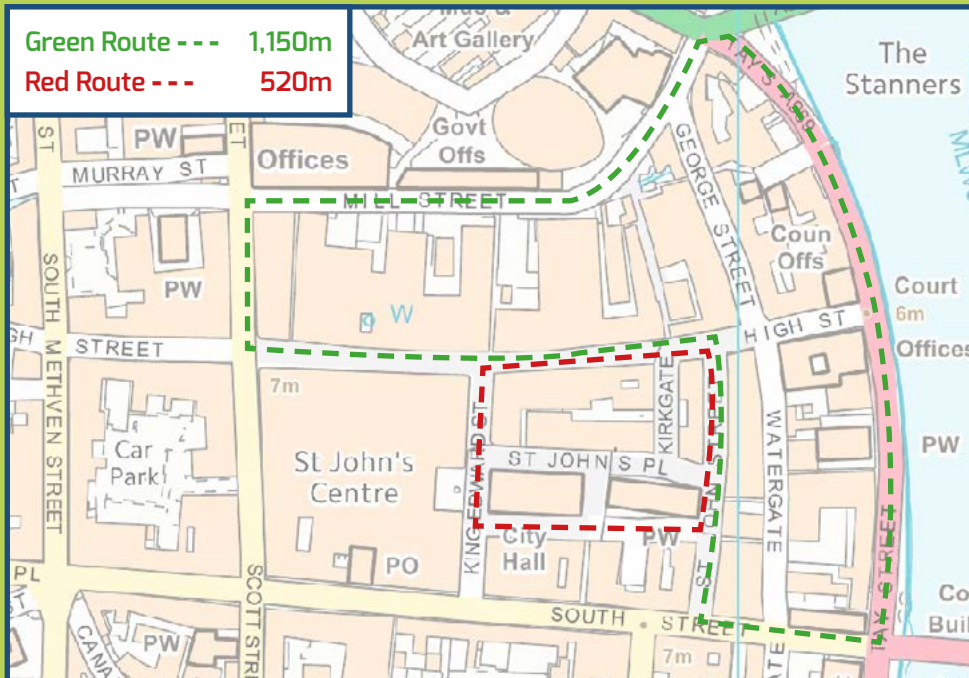
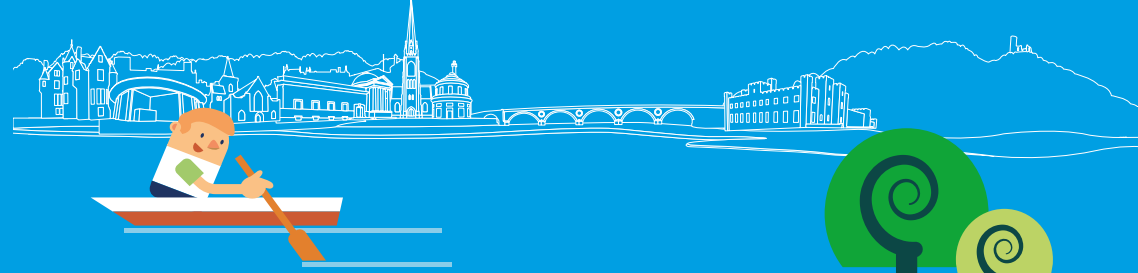

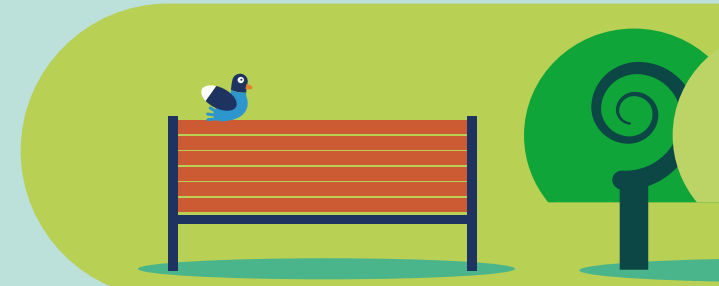

Perth On The Go City Centre Cycle

Get a different view of the city centre as you travel around either the red or green route on your bike (see back page). Bring the kids, grandparents, even your four-legged friends for a day of cycling fun. Both routes have cycle-safe lanes with no traffic so you can cycle the city safely and as often as you like. Comrie Croft will provide a fleet of bikes which can be rented for a small charge, if you don't have your own bike.

- Come and try the Pump Track outside Perth Concert Hall on Horsecross Plaza.
- Electric Bike Scotland - try out an electric bike and other alternative bikes.
- Have a go on a pedal powered smoothie machine.
- Live Active will be on-site promoting accessibility bikes and advertising their group rides.
- Dr Bike maintenance stall showing people how to service their bike and fix simple faults.
- Pedal powered disco will provide some upbeat music to keep people motivated.
- Car garages from the motor mile will show off their newest electric vehicles outside St John's Shopping Centre.
- Visit the Stagecoach bus promoting routes across the city.
- Hop on the bus and travel to Perth On The Go in style on a vintage vehicle. This free service will be available to and from Broxden Park & Ride to the City Centre on the day of the event.

'The Wee Jaunt' (Cycling Scotland event) will start in Perth City Centre outside Perth Concert Hall on Horsecross Plaza from 8.30 am - 11.00 am.
